

CHAPTER LXXXIII.

*An Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Todd county to have records transcribed from Morrison county.*

March 6, 1871.

- SECTION 1. Authorized to appoint a person to transcribe certain records.
- 2. Validity of said records.
- 3. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That the county commissioners of the county of Todd be, and they are hereby authorized and empowered to appoint a competent person to transcribe from the record books of Morrison county all the records having reference to the lands situated, lying and being in Todd county, and which were recorded in said books previous to the organization of Todd county.

Authorized to appoint a person to transcribe certain records.

SEC. 2. That such transcribed records, when made, and duly certified to as correct by the register of deeds of Todd county, shall have the same validity and effect as original records in other counties of the state.

Validity of said records.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage,

When act to take effect.
