SECTION 1. Appropriation for the purpose of procuring necessary apparatus for heating the Capitol with steam-in what amount.

## CHAPTER CIL

An Act to provide for supplying the Capitol Building with water from the City Water Works.

SECTION 1. Appropriation for the purpose of supplying Capitol building with water—in what amount.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the sum of four hundred and fifty (450) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be, and the same are hereby appropriated out of any to building with monies in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of introducing water pipes into the capitol building, and supplying said building with water; also, for providing a "nozzle," or fire plug within the building, and a supply of hose to be used in case of fire. And said amount shall be used and expended under the supervision of the governor.

When act to take SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its effect passage.
