

CHAPTER XLIII.

An Act to amend Section six of Chapter sixty-three of the General Statutes relating to the general terms of the Supreme Court.

- SECTION 1. Amendment to section 6, chapter 63 of general statutes changing the time of holding terms of supreme court.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Terms of
Supreme Court

SECTION 1. That section six, of chapter sixty-three of the general statutes be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 6. There shall be two general terms of the supreme court held at the seat of government of the state, one on the first Tuesday in April and one on the first Tuesday in October.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after the first day of May, 1872.
