persons claiming to be members shall present their certificate and take the oath required by the constitution; and shall if a quorum is present, thereupon proceed to elect in the order named viva voce, a speaker, a clief clerk, an assistant clerk, a second assistant clerk, an enrolling clerk, an assistant enrolling clerk, who shall also perform the duties of post-master of the house, an engrossing clerk, sergeant-at-arms, and an assistant sergeant-at-arms, who shall also perform the duties of door keeper, and a chaplain.

Section eight of said chapter is hereby amended by striking therefrom the word "fireman" where office of fireit occurs therein: Provided, that the present incumbent man abolished. shall be and perform the duties of assistant sergeant-at-arms

during the present session.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LIX.

An Act to amend Section One Hundred and Three of Chapter Eight of the General Statutes relating to the Board of County Commissioners.

- Section 1. Amendment to section 103 of chapter'S of general statutes, relating to county commissioners.
 - 2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section "one hundred and three (103) Relating to of chapter eight (8) of the general statutes is amended by county comstriking out the word "second" in the first line, and insert-missioners. ing in lieu thereof the word "third."

This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
