## CHAPTER LX.

March 1, 1872. An Act amending Section Fifty-Eight of Chapter Ten of the General Statutes.

SECTION 1. Amendment to section 58, of chapter 10 of general statutes.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Secritor 1. That section fifty-eight of chapter ten (10) of the general statutes be amended so as to read as follows:

Relating to contagious diseases. Section 58. When any person coming from abroad or residing in any town or city within this state is infected or lately has been infected with the small pox or other contagious disease dangerous to the public health, the board of health of the town or city where such sick or infected person is, may immediately cause such person to be removed to a separate house, if it can be done without danger to his health, and shall provide for such person or persons, nurses, medical attendance and other necessaries which shall be a charge in favor of such town or city upon the person so provided for, his parents, guardian or master, if able, otherwise upon the county to which he belongs or upon the state if said person be a non-resident of the state.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after its passage.
