## CHAPTER LXXIV.

March 1, 1872. An Act to amend Section Seven of Chapter Ninety Eight of the General Statutes.

Section 1. Amendment to section 7 of chapter 98 of the general statutes, relating to wanton destruction of property.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section seven of chapter ninety-eight of the general statutes of Minnesota be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Penalty for unlawful destruction of property Section 7. If any of the persons so unlawfully assembled, demolish, pull down or destroy any dwelling house or any other building, or any shop, steamboat or vessel, he shall be punished by imprisonment in the state prison not more than seven years nor less than three years or by fine not exceeding one thousand dollars in the discretion of the court.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and

after its passage.
