An Act to Repeal Chapter One Hundred and Sixteen (116), of the Special Laws, A. D. 1871, Relating to a Wagon Road in Carleton County.

February 29.

Repeal of chapter 116 of special laws of 1871, relating to a wagon road.

When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

That chapter one hundred and sixteen (116), of the special laws of the year eighteen hundred and seventyone (1871), be and the same is hereby repealed. Provided, That this act shall not be construed to impair any claims reported against the county of Carleton, which the road commissioners named in the said chapter hereby repealed, or their assistants therein authorized, may have on account of their labor performed under or by virtue thereof.

Repeal of chapter 116, special laws of 1971.

This act shall take effect and be in force from when act to and after its passage.
