damages shall be deemed secured, [and] the amount of such appraisal shall be paid by the said LeSueur county.

SEC. 6. That upon filing the appraisal of damages as aforesaid, the said commissioners shall notify any person to whom any damages may be awarded of the amount so awarded him, and any person deeming himself aggrieved by such appraisal of his compensation may appeal therefrom to the district court of the county of LeSueur, within thirty days after receiving notice of such appraisal by serving a notice of such appeal upon the county auditor of said county. The county anditor shall certify a copy of the appraisal appealed from to the district court of said county within ten days after serving the notice of appeal upon him.

SEO. 7. This act shall take effect and be in focree from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CLXII.

March 4, 1873. An Act to Locate, Survey and Establish a State road from Princeton in Mille Lacs County, to Brunswick in Kanabec County.

SECTION 1. Commissioners named to locate a state road.

- 2. Time of meeting of commissioners.
- Per diem of commissioners, and authority to employ a surveyor and other necessary help.
- Expenses of location to be paid by the counties in proportion to the length in each county.
- 5. Damages to bo appraised, and right of appeal to county commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That H. M. Atkins, J. L. Cater and Phineas Gates, are hereby appointed commissioners to locate, survey and establish a state road from Princeton in Mille Lacs county, to Brunswick in Kanabec county.

Þ

SEC. 2. The commissioners shall meet in Princeton, on any day subsequent to the passage of this act, that may be agreed on by them, or a majority of them, and proceed to discharge their duties under this act and if any of said commissioners, appointed under this act shall be unable for any cause to perform the duties imposed by this act, he shall have power to appoint a substitute, who shall have the same power when so appointed, as one of the commissioners named in this act.

SEC. 3. Said commissioners shall be entitled to receive four dollars per day for their services, and are hereby au- thority to emthorized to employ in locating said road two chainmen, one ploy help. ax-man, and one surveyor, which chainmen and ax-man shall be entitled to receive not more than two dollars, and the surveyor not more than four dollars per day for their services rendered by virtue of this act.

The expense of locating said road, shall be paid Expenses of lo-Sec. 4. by the counties in which said road may pass in proportion calling road to the distance it may run in each county.

It shall be the duty of such commissioners to Sec. 5. appraise the damages sustained by each owner of land through which said road may pass, and in case any one shall find himselt aggrieved by such appraisement, he may appeal to the county commissioners of the proper county, at any time within thirty days after such appraisal, and the the said county commissioners shall at their next annual meeting hear and determine such appeal and decide the same as they shall deem just.

Seo. 6. – Said commissioners shall on or before the first day of December 1872, file an accurate and certified plat of said road in the office of the county auditor, in each county in which said road may run, and thereafter, and after the county commissioners of such county through which said state road may extend, have provided for the payment of the damages awarded to the owners of the land through which said road shall pass, said road shall be deemed established.

SEC. 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from when act to and after its passage.
