CHAPTER XVII.

An Act to amend the charter of the city of Wabashaw.

February 26. 1872.

SECTION 1 Amendment to section two of chapter seven of the city charter of Waba shaw, relating to a capitation or poll tax.

- 2. Amendment to subdivision nine of section one of chapter six, relating to the licenting of dogs.
- 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

That section two (2) of chapter seven (7) of the charter of the city of Wabashaw, approved March fifth (5), A. D. one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine (1869), be amended so as to read as follows: That every qualified voter in the city of Wabashaw shall annually pay a capitation or poll tax of one dollar in cash which shall be paid to the street commissioners, on demand, between the first (1) day of May and the first (1) day of June in each and every year; and the same shall be expended under the direction of the street commissioners upon the highways, streets, alleys or bridges, within the limits of the city of Wabashaw.

That subdivision nine (9) of section one (1) Licensing dogs of chapter six (6) of said charter be amended so as to To regulate and license the keeping of read as follows: dogs; to prohibit the running at large of dogs without a license; to impose fines upon the owners and keepers of dogs, and to authorize the destruction of dogs when at large without being licensed, or contrary to any ordinance of the

city of Wabashaw.

That this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
