

CHAPTER CXC.

March 1, 1872. *An Act to Legalize the Actions of John Crapsey, a Justice of the Peace in and for the County of Cottonwood.*

- SECTION 1. Certain official acts legalized.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Certain official
acts legalized.

SECTION 1. That the record of all deeds of land or of any interest therein, made and purporting to have been executed and acknowledged in the month of March, A. D. 1871, before John Crapsey, a justice of the peace in and for the county of Cottonwood, Minnesota, are hereby legalized and made valid, and said record shall have the same force and effect as if the said John Crapsey had, in said month of March, A. D. 1871, been a justice of the peace, duly qualified, in and for the said county of Cottonwood.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
