

CHAPTER CCX.

An Act to Provide for Transcribing Records relating to Real Estate in those portions of the Counties of Scott and Dakota that were affected by the Changing the Boundary Line under an Act approved March 6th, A. D. 1871.

- SECTION 1. Register of deeds of Scott county authorized to transcribe certain records.
2. Register of deeds of Dakota county authorized to transcribe certain records.
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

To transcribe

SECTION 1. That the register of deeds for the county of Scott is hereby authorized and empowered to transcribe from the records of Dakota county all entries and records relating to real estate heretofore in said county, and which was set off into Scott county by the changing of the boundary line, under an act entitled an act to change the boundary line between Scott and Dakota counties, approved March 6th, 1871.

SEC. 2. That the register of deeds for the county of Dakota is hereby authorized and empowered to transcribe from the records of Scott county all entries and records relating to real estate heretofore in said county, and which was set off into Dakota county by the changing of the boundary line, under an act entitled an act to change the boundary line between Scott and Dakota counties, approved March 6th, A. D. 1871.

When act to
take effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
