

Section 19. The officers of said city shall not be entitled to or receive any compensation for their services except as in this act provided. The aldermen shall be entitled to the same compensation as is now allowed by law to inspectors of election for services as such inspectors, to be paid by said city for any special or general election held by authority of the State or county. The street commissioner shall be entitled to two dollars and fifty cents per day for all services required by this act, but shall be paid from moneys arising from assessments for improvements and their compensation shall be included in such assessment.

CHAPTER XLIV.

An Act entitled an Act to Amend Chapter Fifty-four of Special Laws of 1871, relating to corporation of the village of Preston.

- SECTION 1. Amendment to section 3 of chapter 54 of Special Laws of 1871, authorizing a larger issue of railroad bonds.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That section 3 of chapter 54 of the Special Laws of 1871 be amended by striking out the word "fifteen," in the fourth line of said section and inserting in lieu thereof the word "fifty."
