

CHAPTER VI.

*An Act in relation to the vacating of streets, alleys and public squares in the city of St. Paul.*February 28,
1872.

- SECTION 1. Power and authority to vacate streets vested in the City Council.
2. Repeal of inconsistent acts.
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sole power and authority to vacate streets, alleys and public grounds within the city of St. Paul is hereby invested in the common council of said city, and that no street, alley or public grounds shall be vacated by said common council unless three-fourths of all the members elect thereof, shall vote therefor.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts, inconsistent with this act hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
