

## CHAPTER CXVI.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE LEGISLATIVE EXPENSES OF THE PRESENT SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. The sum of five thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the incidental expenses incurred and ordered to be paid by either or both houses thereof.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER CXVII.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE PAYMENT OF SALARIES OF THE OFFICERS OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT FOR THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury belonging to the general revenue fund, for the payment of the salaries of the officers of the state government for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three :

1st.—For the salary of the governor, three thousand dollars.

2d.—For the salary of the secretary of state and superintendent of public printing, eighteen hundred dollars.
