

CHAPTER CXXIX.

AN ACT ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE ERECTION AND FURNISHING CERTAIN BUILDINGS FOR THE USE OF THE MINNESOTA STATE REFORM SCHOOL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

For buildings for
state reform
school—\$15,000.

SECTION 1. That the sum of fifteen thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated for the erection and furnishing of a family building for the use of the Minnesota state reform school.

For shops, \$3,000

SEC. 2. That the sum of three thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the erection and furnishing of shops and a laundry for the use of the Minnesota state reform school.

Act takes effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXXX.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR COMPLETING AND FURNISHING A BUILDING FOR THE THIRD STATE NORMAL SCHOOL AT ST. CLOUD.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of thirty thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury
