not otherwise appropriated, to be expended in completing For completion of and furnishing a building for the third state normal school school-\$80,000. at St. Cloud, the same to be paid on warrants drawn by the president and countersigned by the treasurer of the state normal board, and that on the presentation of such warrants to the state auditor, it shall be his duty to draw warrants on the state treasurer for a like amount, such money to be expended under the direction of the normal school board as provided by law. Provided, That no more than one-half of said sum shall be paid out of the treasury until after the first day of April, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three. And provided, further, That the said sum of thirty thousand dollars shall be sufficient for the erection and completion of the said building, and no further sum shall be appropriated to aid in the erection or completion of the same.

All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with SEC. 2. this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXXXI.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE ERECTION OF BUILDINGS FOR THE STATE UNIVERSITY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of fifty thousand dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in state university the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be expended \$50,000. in the erection of buildings for the state university, the same to be paid on warrants drawn by the president and countersigned by the treasurer of the board of regents, and that on the presentation of such warrants to the state auditor, it shall be his duty to draw warrants on the state treasurer for like amounts, such money to be expended under the direction of the board of regents of the state university.

CHAPTER CXXXII.

That the sum of five thousand dollars, or ^{gaderers by mow} so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the relief of such persons as require medicines and medical and surgical aid and other relief by reason of the late snow [severe] storm upon the frontier and elsewhere in this state, and who are otherwise unable to obtain the same, such money to be drawn by and expended by the governor at his discretion.
