

CHAPTER CXXXVIII.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE UNEXPENDED PORTION OF THE GETTYSBURG BATTLEFIELD MEMORIAL ASSOCIATION FUND, AND DISPOSING OF THE SAME.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That so much of the sum of one thousand dollars, appropriated by an act entitled "An act to appropriate money to aid in preserving the battlefield of Gettysburg," the same being chapter one hundred and one of the general laws of eighteen hundred and seventy, as now remains unexpended, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be drawn upon the order of the governor to be expended by the Antietam association, but only in such way as the governor of this state shall consent to and approve.

Antietam association—balance of \$1,000 appropriated to the Gettysburg memorial fund.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Act takes effect.

CHAPTER CXXXIX.

AN ACT FOR AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE ERECTION OF A MONUMENT TO THE MEMORY OF THE OFFICERS AND SOLDIERS OF THE FIFTH MINNESOTA VOLUNTEER INFANTRY, BURIED AT FORT RIDGELY, MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be expended in the erection of a monument to the memory of the offi-

Monument at Fort Ridgely—\$500.
