How to be erected and paid for.

SEC. 2. That Thomas P. Gere, Wm. Pfaender and M. D. Flower are hereby appointed a committee to contract for said monument, and to draft a suitable superscription for the same. That when said monument is erected as herein provided for, the said committee shall certify that fact to the governor of the state, who shall thereupon issue his warrant upon the state treasurer for said sum of five hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary to defray the expense of erecting such monument.

Act takes effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXL.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO PAY CERTAIN EX-SOLDIERS, MEMBERS OF COMPANY E, SECOND REGIMENT MINNESOTA INFANTRY VOLUNTEERS, FOR NINETEEN DAYS' SERVICE PRIOR TO MUSTERING INTO THE SERVICE OF THE UNITED STATES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Co. E, 2nd Minn. regiment—nineteen days military service—\$ 600.

SECTION 1. That the sum of six hundred dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury belonging to the general revenue fund, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to pay the following named persons or their widows and orphans, for military service from the sixteenth day of June, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one, to the fifth day of July, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one, and who were on said last mentioned day mustered into the second regiment Minnesota infantry as company E thereof:

SEC. 2. That the adjutant general of the state of Minnesota shall prescribe rules as to the proof required of said service, and upon satisfactory proof draw his order upon the treasurer thereof, and deliver the same to the person so serving as aforesaid. Of the proof of service.
