CHAPTER CXLIV.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO PAY THE SHERIFF OF TODD COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA, FOR EXPENSES IN EXECUTING A WARRANT ISSUED BY THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, FOR THE ARREST OF THOMAS J. SUTTON, A FUGITIVE FROM JUSTICE FROM THE STATE. OF INDIANA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of twenty-eight dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to pay L. Henry, sheriff of Todd county, for expenses incurred in executing a warrant for the arrest of Thomas J. Sutton, a fugitive from justice from the state of Indiana.

The state auditor is hereby authorized to draw his warrant on the state treasurer for said amount, to be paid on the order of said L. Henry.

This act shall take effect and be in force from-SEC. 2.

Act takes effect. and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXLV.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO PAY THE CLAIM OF W. P. CLOUGH FOR DISBURSEMENTS ACTUALLY MADE IN PROSECUTING A SUIT AGAINST THE WINONA AND SAINT PETER RAILROAD.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury

L. Henry, sheriff —expenses in executing Gov ernor's warrant.

State Auditor must draw warrant.
