CHAPTER CXLIV.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO PAY THE SHERIFF OF TODD COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA, FOR EXPENSES IN EXECUTING A WARRANT ISSUED BY THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, FOR THE ARREST OF THOMAS J. SUTTON, A FUGITIVE FROM JUSTICE FROM THE STATE. OF INDIANA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of twenty-eight dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to pay L. Henry, sheriff of Todd county, for expenses incurred in executing a warrant for the arrest of Thomas J. Sutton, a fugitive from justice from the state of Indiana.

SEO. 2. The state auditor is hereby authorized to draw his warrant on the state treasurer for said amount, to be paid on the order of said L. Henry.

CHAPTER CXLV.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO PAY THE CLAIM OF W. P. CLOUGH FOR DISBURSEMENTS ACTUALLY MADE IN PROSECUTING A SUIT AGAINST THE WINONA AND SAINT PETER RAILROAD.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury

CHAPTER CXLVI.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO M. V. NICHOLS FOR SERVICES RENDERED UNDER PROCLAMATION OF THE GOVERNOR, DATED JUNE TWENTY-FOURTH, ONE THOU-SAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury M. V. Nichola-belonging to the general revenue fund, not otherwise securing arrest of appropriated, to pay M. V. Nichols for services rendered ing liquor, to Inin securing the arrest and conviction of eight several persons for offenses against the law regarding the sale of intoxicating liquors to Indians.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from Act takes effect. and after its passage.
