CHAPTER CXLVI.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO M. V. NICHOLS FOR SERVICES RENDERED UNDER PROCLAMATION OF THE GOVERNOR, DATED JUNE TWENTY-FOURTH, ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury belonging to the general revenue fund, not otherwise appropriated, to pay M. V. Nichols for services rendered in securing the arrest and conviction of eight several persons for offenses against the law regarding the sale of intoxicating liquors to Indians.
