scribed in this act. The provisions of this act shall be applicable to Washington county only.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from Act takes effect. and after its passage.

## CHAPTER XXIII.

## AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE (1) OF CHAPTER SEVEN-TY-EIGHT (78) OF GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO, BELATING TO THE PROTECTION OF FISH IN THE WATERS OF HENNEPIN, RAMSEY AND WASHINGTON COUNTLES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of chapter seventyeight (78) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two, be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to catch, kill or destroy any fish known by the name of pickerel, Fish not to be or any fish known by the name of bass, from any lake, spawning season. pond or marsh, or from any inlet or outlet thereof, situated and being within the boundaries of the counties of Hennepin, Ramsey and Washington, state of Minnesota, between the fifteenth day of March, and the fitteenth day of May in any year.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
