

CHAPTER LXXV.

AN ACT FIXING THE TIME FOR THE GENERAL TERMS OF THE DISTRICT COURT FOR THE FOURTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. General terms of the district court in the fourth judicial district shall be held each year as follows:

In the county of Hennepin on the third Tuesday in May and the third Tuesday in November. Terms of court in Hennepin county.

In the county of Wright on the first Tuesday in March and the second Tuesday in October. Wright county

In the county of Meeker on the third Tuesday in March and the third Tuesday in October. Meeker county.

In the county of Kandiyohi on the four Tuesday in March and the third Tuesday in September. Kandiyohi county.

In the county of Anoka on the second Tuesday in January. Anoka county.

In the county of Isanti on the first Tuesday in October. Isanti county.

SEC. 2. All actions, process, recognizances and proceedings of whatever nature, had or done for, or returnable to any term of said court in any of said counties as heretofore fixed by law, shall be returnable to the next term for such county as herein specified, and shall be as valid and binding in all respects as though no change had been made. All proceedings returnable to the terms here fixed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
