

## CHAPTER LXXVI.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE TIME OF HOLDING GENERAL TERMS OF THE DISTRICT COURT IN THE COUNTY OF MEEKER, FOURTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. The general terms of the district court in and for the county of Meeker, fourth judicial district, shall be held on the third Tuesday in March and the third Tuesday in October in each year.

Term of court in Meeker county.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. All writs, recognizances, and all other papers and proceedings made returnable to the district court of said county, shall be considered and deemed to be returnable to the terms of said court as the same are fixed by this act, and all continuances, appeals, motions, notices, or other proceedings, taken or made to, or for any term of said court, shall be considered and construed to be made or taken to the terms of said court as fixed by this act.

All proceedings returnable to this term.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
