CHAPTER CXXIII.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY IN AID OF BUILDING A ROAD TO PIGEON RIVER, MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That for the purpose of assisting the counties of Lake and Saint Louis to lay out and build a wagon road from Duluth to Pigeon River, on Lake Superior, in accordance with chapter forty of the general laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, the sum of fifteen hundred dollars is hereby appropriated from the internal improvement fund of this state; and on proof presented to the auditor of the state that the provisions of said chapter forty of the general laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-two have been complied with, the auditor shall draw his warrant on the state treasurer for the sum herein appropriated, in favor of the commissioners legally appointed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER CXXIV.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO AID THE COUNTY OF MARTIN IN THE CONSTURCTION OF A BRIDGE ACROSS THE OUTLET OF EAST CHAIN LAKES, IN SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund or the first moneys which shall come into the treasury belonging to said fund not already appropriated, for the building of a substantial bridge across the outlet of East Chain Lakes, at the East Chain
