

ment of damages in any newspaper published in either of the counties through which the said road may run, shall be sufficient notice as required by this act.

SEC. 7. A majority of the commissioners named in this act shall have full authority to act as required herein, and in case a majority of the said commissioners cannot be found to act, then, upon the notification of such fact by either of the said commissioners, the governor of the state may appoint to fill vacancies.

SEC. 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXLI.

AN ACT TO VACATE A PORTION OF THE TERRITORIAL ROAD RUNNING FROM POINT DOUGLAS TO FORT RIPLEY WHICH WAS CONSTRUCTED UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That all that portion of the territorial road running from Point Douglas to Fort Ripley which was constructed under the authority of the United States Government that lies in section thirty-one (31), of township twenty-eight (28) north, of range twenty-two (22) west, in Ramsey county be, and the same is hereby declared vacated.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
