CHAPTER XXII.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE, CHAPTER NINE, OF SPECIAL LAWS OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY, IN REFERENCE TO THE IN-CORPORATING THE VILLAGE OF EAST JANESVILLE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section one be and is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1. All of the north-east quarter of section twenty-seven, east-half of section thirty-three, and all of section thirty-four, in township one hundred and eight north, of range twenty-four, the north half of section three in township one hundred and seven north, of range twenty-four west, in Waseca county, in the state of Minnesota, shall be known as the village of East Janesville, and by that name may sue and be sued, make contracts, purchase, take and hold real and personal property, and have a corporate seal alterable at pleasure. Every grant and devise of lands, or right, or transfer of property, which has been or may be made for the benefit of its inhabitants, shall have the same effect as if made to the village by name.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force on and after its passage.
