

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to allow any cattle, horses, sheep, swine, or other domestic animals, owned by such persons [person] or persons, or of which such person or persons have control or may be in possession, to run at large upon any public highway or upon the lands of any other person or persons in the county of Nobles and state of Minnesota, during any season of the year, unless they be carefully herded.

SEC. 2. Any person or persons who shall violate or neglect the provisions of the first section of this act shall be liable for all damages that may ensue in consequence of the trespass of such animal or animals.

SEC. 3. All acts and part of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect, and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXVI.

AN ACT TO PREVENT THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF CATTLE AND OTHER DOMESTIC ANIMALS, WITHIN THE COUNTIES OF DODGE AND OLMSTED, MARTIN AND THE SEVENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT OF WINONA COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to allow any cattle, horses, or other domestic animals, owned by them, or of which they may be in possession, or have control, to run at large upon the public highways, or upon the lands of any other person, during any season of the year, unless properly herded; *Provided*, That the provisions of this section shall not apply to any portion of the state of Minnesota except the counties of Dodge, Olmsted, and Martin, and the seventh senatorial district of Winona county.

SEC. 2. All laws inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first day of April, A. D. eighteen hundred and seventy-four.

CHAPTER LXVII.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE T. B. SHELDON AND WILLIAM HOWE TO ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN A FERRY ACROSS THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER AT THE CITY OF RED WING, COUNTY OF GOODHUE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That T. B. Sheldon and William Howe, their heirs, executors, administrators or assigns shall have the exclusive right and privilege for the period of ten years, of keeping and maintaining a ferry across the main channel of the Mississippi river, at the city of Red Wing, in the county of Goodhue, in the state of Minnesota, at any point within one mile eastwardly or westwardly, up and down the Mississippi river, from the foot of Broadway, in said city, where the same strikes said river in said city.

SEC. 2. That said T. B. Sheldon and William Howe, or their assigns, shall, at the opening of uninterrupted navigation of said main channel cause to be placed and maintained upon such ferry, such good and sufficient boat or boats as may be necessary for the accommodation of foot passengers, and to transport across said main channel all teams, horses, cattle and other property, and shall at all times give ready and prompt attention to passengers or teams, on all occasions and at all hours of the day or night, but persons crossing said ferry with teams or otherwise after nine o'clock at night, may be charged double the fare hereinafter prescribed.

SEC. 3. That said T. B. Sheldon and William Howe, their heirs or assigns may land their boats, passengers and property on any public street or highway, which may terminate within the points above specified, or on the lands of any person first having obtained their permission to do so.

SEC. 4. That the said T. B. Sheldon and William Howe, or their assigns, shall, within one year after the passage of this act file or cause to be filed with the county auditor of Goodhue county, a bond running to the board of commissioners of said county, with two or
