## CHAPTER LXXX.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE ACTS, PROCEEDINGS, ORGANIZATION AND TITLE TO THE CHURCH PROPERTY OF THE FIRST CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH OF ST. ANTHONY, AND THE APPOINTMENT OF THEIR TRUS-TEES AND TO AUTHORIZE THEIR TRUSTEES TO SELL AND CONVEY CHURCH PROPERTY.

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the acts, proceedings and organization of the First Congregational Church of St. Anthony be and the same is hereby legalized and made valid, and especially the election of the trustees, G. Campbell, M. D. Stoneman and Elijah Moulton be and the same is hereby legalized and made valid.

SEC. 2. The aforesaid trustees are hereby authorized and empowered to sell and convey the church property and all property deeded to the First Congregational Church of St. Anthony and to the trustees of said church, and turn over the proceeds of said sale or sales to the First Congregational Society of St. Anthony.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER LXXXI.

AN ACT TO VACATE THE TOWN OF MIDWAY, IN COTTONWOOD COUNTY AND TO ATTACH THE SAME TO THE TOWN OF MOUNTAIN LAKE, IN SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The town of Midway, in the county of Cottonwood, in the state of Minnesota, to-wit: Township one hundred and six
