## CHAPTER XCVII.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LAKE CITY, IN THE COUNTY OF WABASHA, TO THE TOWN OF LAKE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the name of the township of Lake City, in the county of Wabasha, be and the same is hereby changed to the township of Lake.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

## CHAPTER XCVIII.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE ORGANIZED TOWN OF GEORGE-TOWN, IN THE COUNTY OF COTTONWOOD, TO AMO.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the name of the organized town of "Georgetown," in the county of Cottonwood and state of Minnesota, be and the same is hereby changed to that of "Amo," by which name it shall hereafter be known and designated in all conveyances of real estate therein, and for all other purposes.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first day of May, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-

three.
