

CHAPTER CXIX.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE SUPPORT OF
THE INDIGENT INSANE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

For the support
of the insane.

SECTION 1. That the sum of eighty-four thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated for the current expenses of the Minnesota hospital for insane, and for furnishing the new buildings now under contract and nearly completed, the same to be paid in warrants drawn by the president and countersigned by the secretary of the board of trustees of that institution, and that on the presentation of such warrants on the state auditor, it shall be his duty to draw warrants on the state treasurer for like amount, such money to be expended under the direction of the board of trustees of the Minnesota hospital for the insane. But not more than eight thousand dollars shall be expended for furnishing the asylum, nor shall any part of the moneys hereby appropriated be used for any other purposes whatever than those mentioned in this section. *Provided*, That the sum herein appropriated for current expenses shall be drawn monthly in advance upon the estimated expenses for said institution.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
