CHAPTER CXXVI.

AN ACT APPROPRIATING MONEY FOR THE USE OF THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT OF THE STATE GOVERN-MENT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The sum of one hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropri- unve of executive department ated out of any money in the treasury belonging to the general revenue fund not otherwise appropriated, for postage for the executive department of the state government, and the state auditor is hereby authorized to draw his warrant upon the state treasurer for the payment of said sum to the governor of this state.

CHAPTER CXXVII.

AN ACT APPROPRIATING MONEY TO THE MAGDALEN SO-CIETY OF MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:
