2d.—For payment of balance due state printer for work done by contract for state in eighteen hundred and seventy-three (1873), ten thousand seven hundred and thirty-six 23-100 dollars (\$10,736.23).

3d.—For payment of balance due for publishing general laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-three (1873), in newspapers, fifteen hundred and seventy-seven 25-100 dollars (\$1,577.25).

4th.—For payment of amount due for advertising for the various state departments in eighteen hundred and seventy-three (1873); one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

5th.—This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXXX. .

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE PURPOSES THEREIN NAMED.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of six hundred dollars (\$600) or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated for the purpose of buying a safe for the executive office. Said sum to be paid out of the treasury upon the order of the governor.
