CHAPTER XVIII.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 21 AND 22 OF TITLE TWO OF CHAPTER 35 OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF MINNE-SOTA, RELATING TO STATE CHARITABLE INSTITUTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Compensation of secretary.

Section 1. That section 21 of title two of chapter 35. of the general statutes of Minnesota, be amended by adding thereto the following: The secretary shall perform such duties consistent with his office as said board shall require, and shall receive for such services a sum not exceeding one hundred dollars per annum.

SEC. 2. That section 22 of said title two be amended

so as to read as follows:

Compensation of Attectors.

Sec. 22. No one of said directors except said treasurer and secretary shall receive any compensation for his services, but may be allowed reasonable traveling expenses incurred in attending the meetings of said board.

When act to take SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from effect

and after its passage.

CHAPTER XIX.

AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE DISTINCTION BETWEEN "PUB-LIC" AND "PRIVATE" PATIENTS IN THE HOSPITAL FOR THE INSANE FOR THE STATE OF MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Every insane person who is a bona flde resident of this state shall be admitted to the hospital for the insane for the state of Minnesota and maintained at resident patients.
