CHAPTER XLVII.

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION NINETEEN AND TWENTY-ONE OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED OF THE GENERAL STATUTES RELATING TO SABBATH KEEPING OR SAB-BATH BREAKING.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesola:

SECTION 1. Section nineteen of chapter one hundred general statutes, is hereby amended by adding the following words:

Provided, This section shall not apply to any person Relating to mbwho religiously observes the seventh day of the week, commonly called Saturday, as the Sabbath, so far as relates to his work or business avocations.

> This act shall take effect and be in force from SEC. 2. and after its passage.

CHAPTER XLVIII.

AN ACT TO PUNISH GAMBLERS UPON CARS AND STEAM-BOATS.
