Validity of conveyances.

SEC. 2. That all deeds of lands heretofore made and executed by the said Francis M. Crosby, judge as aforesaid, under the trust by said several acts created, be and they hereby are declared to be as legal and valid conveyances of the lands therein described as if executed by the original trustee, and the record of any such deeds are hereby declared to be legal and competent evidence from the time of the record thereof, in like manner as the record of other deeds are or may be by law made evidence.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from when act to take and after its passage.

## CHAPTER LXXXIII.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE ORGANIZATION OF THE COUNTY OF NOBLES AND TO LEGALIZE THE OFFICIAL ACTS OF THE OFFICERS OF SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

County legally organized.

Section 1. That the proceedings for the organization of the county of Nobles be and the same are hereby legalized, and the said county of Nobles is hereby declared to be a legally organized county, and the official acts of the officers of said county since its organization are hereby legalized.
