## CHAPTER XCI.

AN ACT TO DETACH THE COUNTY OF ROCK FROM THE COUNTY OF NOBLES FOR JUDICIAL PURPOSES, AND TO ORGANIZE THE SAME FOR JUDICIAL PURPOSES, AND TO PROVIDE FOR GENERAL TERMS OF THE DISTRICT COURT THEREIN.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the county of Rock is hereby detached from the county of Nobles for judicial purposes, and is hereby declared to be organized for judicial purposes, with all the rights, privileges and immunities of counties of this state organized for judicial purposes.

Rock detached from Nobles.

SEC. 2. General terms of the district court shall be held in and for said county of Rock on the first Tuesday of April in each year.

Term of court therein.

SEC. 3. All judicial proceedings now pending in, and all recognizances and writs returnable to the district court in the county of Nobles from the county of Rock shall be made pending in and returnable to the district court in said county of Rock, and all papers on file with the clerk of the district court in said Nobles county which appertain unto said county of Rock shall be immediately transferred to the clerk of said court in said Rock county, and all records in the office of the clerk of the district court of said Nobles county which appertain unto said Rock county shall be transcribed and recorded in the office of the clerk of the district court in said Rock county.

All proceedings returnable to Rock county.

SEC. 4. This act shall be a general act, and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.
