## CHAPTER CXLIV.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR ORGANIZING AS A TOWN CONGRESSIONAL TOWNSHIP NUMBER ONE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN, IN RANGE NUMBER THIRTY-FIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF REDWOOD.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Whenever a majority of the legal voters in congressional township number one hundred and eleven, in range number thirty-five, in the county of Redwood, shall petition the board of county commissioners of said county to be organized as a town under the provisions of the general statutes of the state, said board shall forthwith proceed to organize the same as a town, under the provisions of such statutes, without regard to the number of legal voters contained in said congressional township.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

## CHAPTER CXLV.

AN ACT TO VACATE A PART OF GREENVALE CEMETERY IN THE TOWN OF SAUK CENTRE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Blocks lettered "C," "D," "E" and "F," of the Greenvale Cemetery, in the town of Sauk Centre in the county of Stearns, according to the plat thereof recorded in the office of the register of deeds of said county, together with all the streets, alleys and walks pertaining to the same, excepting the street running north and south along the eastern boundary of said blocks, are hereby vacated and declared to be no longer any part of said cemetery nor of the plat thereof.
