Be it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

That our senators and representatives in congress are requested to use their influence to secure a post route from Banks, in Faribault county, Minnesota, by way of Coon Grove and Benson's Grove to Forest City, in Winnebago county, in the state of Iowa, a disiance of about fifty mile.

Resolved, That the postmaster general is requested to establish post offices in Coon Grove and Benson's Grove, in said county of Winnebago county, Iowa, and to place the requisite service on said route so soon as the route shall be duly authorzed by act of congress.

SECTION 1. That our senators and representatives in congress are hereby requested to use their influence to secure a post route from Buffalo, (the county seat,) in Wright county, by the way of Pelican Lake and Frankfort, in said county, to Dayton, in Hennepin county.
