## CHAPTER CXXVII.

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE CATCHING OF FISH IN LAKE RIPLEY, IN THE TOWN OF LITCHFIELD, MEEKER COUN-TY, DURING CERTAIN SEASONS OF THE YEAR.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to take any fish in Lake Ripley, Meeker county, Minne at Manner of any season of the year, in any other manner than by use catching ash, of a spear or book and line, as hereinafter provided.

SEC. 2. Whoever takes, catches, or kills any fish, of any kind, in said lake, between the first day of March and the penalty for first day of June in any year, in any manner whatsoever, save violation. by hook and line, shall suffer a fine of one dollar for each and every fish so taken, caught, or killed.

SEC. 8. All prosecutions under this act shall be commenced within sixty days from the time such offense was committed, Prosecutions, and the same shall be upon complaint, under oath, before any justice of the peace, in the county where such offense was committed; and all fines imposed and collected under this act, shall be paid into the treasury of said Meeker county, for the use of the common schools of said county.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and when act to after its passage.

## CHAPTER CXXVIII.

AN ACT TO REGULATE FISHING IN THE COUNTIES OF ISANTI AND CHISAGO.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Excluding from certain pro-

SECTION 1. That the counties of Isanti and Chisago be and are hereby exempted and excluded from the operation of all acts and parts of acts prohibiting, restricting, or regulating the catching of fish in any of the waters in said counties, and that the following provisions shall only apply in and to the said counties of Isanti and Chisago.

Manner of catching fish.

SEC. 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to use any seine or drag net in any lake or body of water within the counties of Isanti and Chisago, or any other net with meshes less than one and one-half inches square; and it shall be unlawful for any person to construct or maintain any trap net or other contrivance across any stream, creek, or other narrow passage or body of water, so as to obstruct the passage of fish therein.

lation.

SEC. 3. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this Penalty for vio- act shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by fine not less than ten nor more than twenty-five dollars for each and every offense so committed.

Prosecutions.

SEC. 4. All proceedings under this act shall be commenced within thirty days after the offense was committed, and shall be brought in the same manner as provided by law in similar cases and all fines arising from such prosecutions shall be equally dvided between the person making the complaint and the general school fund.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER CXXIX.

AN ACT TO REPEAL CHAPTER TWENTY-FIVE OF THE GEN-ERAL LAWS OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE, ENTITLED, "AN ACT TO PREVENT THE DESTRUC-TION OF FISH FROM THE WATER[S] WITHIN THE COUN-TIES OF DOUGLAS, TODD, WILKIN, TRAVERSE, POLK, CLAY, CASS, BELTRAMI AND PEMBINA."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Repeal of former act.

SECTION 1. That chapter twenty-five of the general laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-three, entitled, "An act to prevent the destruction of fish from the waters within the counties of Douglas, Todd, Wilkin, Traverse, Polk, Clay, Cass, Beltrami and Pembina," be, and the same hereby is repealed.
