### CHAPTER CXXXII.

## AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER FORTY-FOUR, GENERAL LAWS EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR, ENTITLED, "APACT TO MAKE IT LAWFUL TO CATCH FISH WITH NETS IN CERTAIN LAKES IN KANDIYOHI COUNTY."

#### Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one of chapter forty-four of the general laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows, to-wit:

SEC. 2. That it shall be lawful for any person, at all times, to catch fish with nets, in which the meshes are not less than one and one-half inches across, in Foote Lake, Eagle Lake, Grass Lake, Green Lake, Norway Lake, Lake Andrews, and Lake Houada.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
