CHAPTER CLXV.

AN ACT TO REIMBURSE THE COUNTY OF WATONWAN FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE CAPTURE, TRIAL AND CONVICTION OF ANDREW JOHNSON.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars be, and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to reimburse the county of Watonwan for the expenses of capturing and bringing back from the city of Omaha, in the territory of Nebraska, to the county of Watonwan, Andrew Johnson, and for the expenses of trial and conviction, for the murder of Lars F. Johnson. To pay expenses of capturing and convicting a murderer.

Sec. 2. That the state auditor draw a warrant on the state treasurer, in favor of the county of Watonwan, for said amount, and transmit the same, by mail or otherwise, to the treasurer of Watonwan county, who shall draw the money and place the same to the county revenue fund. Appropriation, how drawn.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.

CHAPTER CLXVI.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO FINISH AND FURNISH, AND FOR GAS MACHINERY AND FIXTURES, FOR THE MINNESOTA HOSPITAL FOR THE INSANE.
