CHAPTER XXIV.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION FIVE OF CHAPTER TWO, GEN-ERAL LAWS OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE, AN ACT FOR THE REGULATION AND GOVERN-MENT OF THE STATE NORMAL SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Limitation of salaries.

That section five of chapter two, general laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-three, entitled an act for the regulation and government of the State Normal Schools, shall be so amended as to read as follows, after the words, "to fix the salaries of the same:" Provided, That no professor or teacher shall receive more than two thousand dollars per annum for salaries or services so rendered.

CHAPTER XXV.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION THIRTY-FIVE, CHAPTER THIR-TY-SIX, STATUTES EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX. BEING SECTION SIXTY-NINE, CHAPTER FIFTEEN, BIS-SELL'S STATUTES, RELATING TO TAXES FOR MAINTAIN-ING PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section thirty-five, chapter thirty-six, statutes eighteen hundred and sixty-six, being section sixty-nine, chapter fifteen, Bissell's statutes, be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 69. For the purpose of maintaining public schools, the commissioners of each county shall levy an annual tax of onetenth of one per cent. on the amount of the assessment made and collected. by the assessors of each township for the same year, which tax so levied shall be extended upon the assessment rolls of the year by the county auditor in a column for each school district or portion thereof in said county, and this shall be collected in the same manner, and by the same persons as other county taxes are collected, except that the school tax shall be collected in gold or silver, or United States national currency, and the money so collected shall be paid into the county treasury for Fines to be set the support of public schools, to be apportioned by the county apart for use of auditor who shall distribute to each school district or portion thereof, the amount of tax collected in said district or portion of district in his said county. As a further provision for the support of schools there shall be set apart by the county treasurer of each county, the proceeds of all fines for the breach of any penal law in this state not otherwise appropriated by law, and all moneys arising from the issuing of liquor licenses and from unclaimed moneys arising from the sale of estrays as provided for by amendment to section twelve, chapter nineteen of the general statutes. And the county auditor shall open an account with each district or portion of district in his county, Auditor to keep and keep an accurate account of all moneys received by or due each district. to each of said districts, and all such matters as are necessary to show the condition of accounts between each of said districts and the county treasury, and for this purpose he shall examine any and all of the books in the office of the county treasurer.
