

from time to time employ any suitable person being an attorney of a court of record, to perform the legal services which such county may need; and whenever there is no county attorney for the county, or when he is absent at the session of the district court for the county, and no attorney has been employed by the board of county commissioners to attend at such session, the court shall appoint if necessary, by an order to be entered in the minutes of the court, some suitable person to perform for such term of court the duties required by law to be performed by the county attorney; and the person employed or appointed shall receive a reasonable compensation for his services, to be allowed by the board of county commissioners, and paid out of the treasury of such county, which amount shall be deducted from the salary of the county attorney.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.

CHAPTER XXX.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS ONE HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE AND TWO HUNDRED OF TITLE ELEVEN, CHAPTER EIGHT OF THE GENERAL STATUTES, (THE SAME BEING SECTIONS ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FOUR AND ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE OF STATUTES AT LARGE,) RELATING TO COUNTY SURVEYORS AND DEPUTIES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one hundred and ninety-nine, title eleven of chapter eight of general statutes, the same being sections one hundred and twenty-four and one hundred and twenty-five of statutes at large, be amended by adding after the word "duties" in the seventh line: and he shall have power to administer oaths to chainmen and other persons under his charge.

Surveyors authorized to administer oaths

SEC. 2. That section two hundred, title eleven, chapter eight of general statutes be amended by adding after the word "corporation" in the fifth line: and each of said deputies shall have power to administer oaths to chainmen and other persons under their charge.

Deputy surveyors authorized to administer oaths.

SEC. 3. That this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.
