ceedings in the probate of a will," is hereby amended by adding Powervested in thereto and at the end thereof the following words: And when administrator ever by the terms of a will the person (or persons) therein vey real estate. named as executor or executrix is empowered to sell and convey real estate, an administrator with such will annexed, appointed to execute the same, shall have the same power to sell and convey real estate that the person (or persons) named therein as executor or executrix could have had in executing such will.

CHAPTER LV.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE OF CHAPTER FIFTY-ONE OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

1876 - 60 Personal eg-

Section 1. That section one of chapter fifty-one of the Personal estrevised statutes of Minnesota be amended so as to read as tate, how disfollows: The widow, if any, shall be allowed all her articles of apparel and ornaments, and all the wearing apparel of the deceased; his household furniture, not exceeding in value five hundred dollars, and other personal property to be selected by her, not exceeding in value four hundred dollars; and this allowance shall be made as well when the widow receives the provisions made for her in the will of her husband, as when he dies intestate.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and When act to after its passage.
