

CHAPTER LXXIX.

AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW JUDICIAL DISTRICT, TO BE KNOWN AS THE TWELFTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ELECTION OF A JUDGE THEREIN.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Detached for judicial purposes.

SECTION 1. That the counties of Stevens, Traverse, and Wilkin be and the same are hereby detached from the seventh judicial district, for judicial purposes.

Detached for judicial purposes.

SEC. 2. That the counties of Meeker, Swift and Kandiyohi be and the same are hereby detached from the fourth judicial district, for judicial purposes.

Detached for judicial purposes.

SEC. 3. That the counties of Chippewa, Lac qui Parle, Yellow Medicine and Big Stone, be and the same are hereby detached from the ninth judicial district, for judicial purposes.

What to constitute the twelfth district.

SEC. 4. That the counties of Meeker, Kandiyohi, Stevens, Traverse, Wilkin, Swift, Chippewa, Lac qui Parle, Yellow Medicine and Big Stone, be and they are hereby erected into a new judicial district, to be known and designated as the twelfth judicial district of Minnesota.

Judge to be appointed to fill vacancy.

SEC. 5. A district judge shall be elected therefor at the next general election, and the governor is hereby authorized to fill the vacancy by appointment until such election.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXXX.

AN ACT TO FIX THE TIMES FOR HOLDING GENERAL TERMS OF THE DISTRICT COURT IN THE TWELFTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

1876-75
Fixing terms of court in the twelfth judicial district.

SECTION 1. General terms of the district court shall hereafter be held in the several counties composing the twelfth judicial district, as follows :

In the county of Meeker, on the third Tuesday of March, and on the first Tuesday of October, in each year ;

In the county of Kandiyohi, on the fourth Tuesday of March and on the fourth Tuesday of September, in each year ;

In the county of Swift, on the first Tuesday of September, in each year ;

In the county of Yellow Medicine, on the second Tuesday of September in each year ;

In the county of Chippewa, for the counties of Chippewa and Lac qui Parle, on the first Tuesday of June in each year ;

In the county of Stevens, for the counties of Stevens, Big Stone and Traverse, on the third Tuesday of June in each year ;

In the county of Wilkin, on the second Tuesday of June in each year.

SEC. 2. All writs, process, bonds, continuances, appeals, notices, proceedings and recognizances issued, made, or returnable to the general terms of court in and for said counties, as respectively fixed by law prior to the passage of this act, shall be deemed and construed as made, taken and returnable to the proper term of said court in the said counties, respectively, as fixed by this act.

All proceedings returnable to said terms.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

When act to take effect.

CHAPTER LXXXI.

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE THREE, OF CHAPTER THIRTY-TWO, OF THE GENERAL STATUTES, RELATING TO RECORDS OF THE SURVEYS OF LOGS AND LUMBER, BEING SECTION SEVENTEEN, OF CHAPTER TWENTY-FIVE, OF THE STATUTES AT LARGE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That subdivision fourth of section seventeen of chapter thirty-two of the general statutes, as amended by section two of chapter twenty-eight of the general laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-one, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows :

Fourth.—A book to be kept in ledger form, in which shall be posted and recorded, as soon as any logs or timber is surveyed, separately and under their respective marks, all the logs and timber of each particular mark surveyed, together with the date of scale, the number of logs and the number of
