

CHAPTER CVIII.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE PROCEEDINGS OF SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER THIRTY-EIGHT, IN THE COUNTY OF HENNEPIN.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the proceedings of the special meeting of school district number thirty-eight, in Hennepin county, held on the twenty-first day of November, A. D. eighteen hundred and seventy-four, in the election of Eugene Guimont as clerk of said district, is hereby legalized.

SEC. 2. That the location of the school house in said district upon the following tract of land, namely: commencing at a point on the section line which divides sections eight and nine, in township one hundred and twenty north, of range twenty-two west, where the north side of the county road from Minneapolis to Dayton crosses said section line; thence running north on said section line eighty feet; thence west fifty feet; thence south to the north line of said road; thence east along the said north line of said road to the place of beginning, is hereby legalized.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CIX.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE LEVYING OF A TAX IN SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER FIFTY-THREE, IN THE COUNTY OF MARTIN.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the tax voted to be levied by school district number fifty-three, in the county of Martin, in the year eighteen hundred and seventy-four, is hereby legalized.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
