

Sec. 9. The common council shall in the month of April in each year elect an assessor, who shall perform all the duties relating to the assessing of property for the purpose of the levying of all city, county and state taxes; and upon the completion of the assessment roll, he shall return the same to the common council, who may alter, revise and equalize the same as it may deem just and proper, and said assessment, as revised and equalized by the common council, shall be returned to the board of county commissioners, and be subject to further revision and equalization by said county board, or by the state board of equalization. The assessor shall hold his office for one year, and until his successor is elected and qualified.

Sec. 2. That division first of section three of chapter four of said charter be amended by adding thereto at the commencement thereof the following: "To license and regulate hawkers and peddlers, and also public halls and all other buildings and enclosures used for places of public resort and amusement, and also all that class of stores known as "dollar stores," and all stores of similar character and purposes."

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XVI.

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE CORPORATION LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MANKATO.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the west one-fourth of the west one-half of the east half of section seventeen, and also the west one-fourth of the west one-half of the southeast quarter of section eight, in township one hundred and eight, north of the base line, and in range twenty-six, west of the fifth principal meridian, be attached to and embraced within the corporate limits of said city of Mankato.

Sec. 2. That said portion of said section eight be included in and form a part of ward number one, and that the north half of said portion of said section seventeen be included in and form a part of ward number two, and that the south half of said portion of said section seventeen be included in and form a part of ward three.

Sec. 3. That this act be in force from and after its passage.
