

CHAPTER CLXXXVIII.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO AID IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF A ROAD FROM DULUTH TO PIGEON RIVER, IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the sum of one thousand dollars is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury, belonging to the internal improvement fund, or out of the first moneys which shall come into the treasury belonging to said fund not already appropriated, to aid in the building of a road from Duluth to Pigeon river, in the state of Minnesota.

SEC. 2. That said road shall be built under the direction of Christian Welland, John Hopkinson and Henry Mayhew, who are hereby appointed commissioners for that purpose.

SEC. 3. That C. P. Baily, W. W. Spaulding and Nils Hall, of St. Louis county, are hereby appointed a committee on the part of the state to examine all contracts and vouchers, and accounts respecting the construction and cost of said road, and make a report of such cost to the state auditor ; and any two of said committee may act in the premises ; *Provided*, That the said committee shall serve without compensation.

SEC. 4. That upon the receipt of said report by the state auditor, he shall, on demand of said committee, draw his order or orders in favor of said committee on the state treasurer for moneys belonging to the said fund, for the expense of building said road aforesaid, not to exceed the sum of one thousand dollars ; and the said committee shall, upon receipt of said sum of money, make the proper disbursement of the same.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
