AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO REIMBURSE MATHIAS SEIBENALER FOR EXPENSES INCURRED BY HIM AS CONTESTANT IN THE CONTESTED ELECTION CASE OF MATHIAS SEIBENALER, CONTESTANT, AND CHARLES A. BAKER, RESPONDENT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated to reimburse Appropriation Mathias Seibenaler for expenses incurred him as contestant in for contested the contested election case of Mathias Seibenaler, contestant, estand Charles A. Baker, respondent, in the house of representatives, the sum of three hundred dollars.
